Education Financial Assistance

- letter of request for financial assistance, identifying the amount required and detailing the reason(s) for each amount;
- Letter of Acceptance from the education institution;
- letter from the NWT Student Financial Assistance program;
- letter(s) from other funding agencies; and
- official school transcripts.

The correct information will ensure that we deal with your application as quickly as possible and that there is less delay in receiving your financial assistance from the GTC.

We also remind you to keep a copy of your faxed confirmation to verify that your documents were sent on or before any deadlines.

We support your educational goals and will do our best – as you do your best in your studies – to serve you.
